



MANA del Norte 2023-24 Scholarship Application Packet

Deadline: Friday, June 30, 2023

General Information and Instructions

PURPOSE

The purpose of the *MANA del Norte* Scholarship is to assist Latina/Hispana women from northern New Mexico in continuing and/or completing their post-secondary education. The philosophy of the founding members of *MANA del Norte* was to focus on the non-traditional student, such as single heads of household, re-entry (education/employment), and first-generation college bound. Although this criterion is not exclusive in awarding scholarships, *MANA del Norte* strongly endorses this philosophy. Scholarships are awarded based on strength of personal statement, financial need, academic ability, and letters of recommendation.

APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicant will receive a "friend/student" membership to MANA del Norte for the 2023-24 year. Please fill out the student/friend membership application included in this packet. Please note the friend/student fee will be waived for applicant.
2. Applicant must be enrolled or plan to be enrolled, by the beginning of the 2023-24 academic year, in an accredited college or university. Both undergraduate and graduate students are eligible to apply.
3. Applicant must be enrolled or plan to be enrolled at least half-time. For purposes of *MANA del Norte's* application criteria, "half-time enrollment" means at least six (6) credit hours.
4. Applicant must demonstrate an ability to benefit from this scholarship. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.
5. Applicant must be a current or former resident of one of the following six (6) northern New Mexico counties: Los Alamos, Mora, Rio Arriba, Santa Fe, San Miguel, or Taos.
6. Applicant's Personal Statement **must** include information addressing this eligibility requirement, i.e., a brief description of your family heritage and cultural background and personal connection to NM.

The following documents **must** be included in your mailed application packet, in this order:

- 1) Application Checklist**
- 2) Scholarship Application Form**
- 3) Personal Statement**
- 4) Financial Need Statement**
- 5) Letters of Recommendation**
- 6) Transcripts**

New applicants:

Submit a 2-3 pages maximum (12 pt. font, double-spaced) personal statement addressing the following:

- What is your cultural background and tie to NM? What does it mean to you to be Latina/Hispana?
- What is your history living in New Mexico?
- Please explain any special circumstances or challenges you and/or your family have faced.
- What are your educational and career goals?
- Indicate any current or previous leadership activities that demonstrate your leadership qualities, the level and nature of your involvement, and the total number of hours spent on each activity.
- Describe any current or previous community service/volunteer activities including participation in MANA del Norte.
- Indicate any recognition or honors received.

Renewal applicants who have previously received a MANA del Norte Scholarship:

In addition to the above requested information, submit a 2-3 pages maximum (12 pt. font, double-spaced) personal statement addressing the following:

- Academic challenges and successes since receiving a scholarship from MANA del Norte
- Your involvement with MANA del Norte since receiving your past-scholarship

Financial Need Statement: (attach a separate financial need statement)

- What is your financial need? (For example, single parent, medical expenses, or other unanticipated circumstances impacting your ability to begin or complete your educational goals). It is strongly recommended that all applicants answer this question. If left unanswered, it will be assumed that the applicant has no financial need.

Unofficial transcript(s) from all institutions attended (high school and/or college):

- Transcripts may be provided electronically. Unofficial transcripts may be provided, however, official transcripts may be required prior to final decisions and award. Please contact the MANA del Norte Scholarship Committee Co-Chair if you have any difficulty in securing an official transcript.

Two letters of recommendation:

- From academic counselor/advisor, teacher/instructor, work supervisor, or community/volunteer representative. At least one reference from a teacher/instructor/academic counselor/advisor preferred. Please include letters in a sealed envelope, with the signature of the person making the recommendation written across the back flap of the envelope OR recommender can email scholarship Co-Chair directly with the letter. APPLICATION DEADLINE

Your application packet must be submitted to MANA del Norte by regular mail **by Friday, June 30, 2023**. **Mailed applications must be postmarked on or before the deadline.**

DO NOT submit applications via certified mail. *Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.*

SELECTION

Scholarship application packets postmarked by the deadline will be reviewed and evaluated by the Scholarship Committee, comprised of MANA del Norte members.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS AND REQUIREMENTS

This year, up to ten (10) MANA del Norte Scholarships will be awarded; amount of \$1,000 each.

Selected recipients will receive their scholarship awards and will be honored at *MANA del Norte's* Scholarship Event on Saturday, September 23 (time & location TBD), held annually during National Hispanic Heritage Month, mid-September through mid-October. Scholarship recipients are asked to participate in the event. The scholarship awards will be made payable to selected applicants upon receipt of **Proof of Enrollment for the Fall 2023 semester**.

Recipients are strongly encouraged to participate in a *MANA del Norte* follow-up activity (i.e., attend a board meeting, complete survey, focus group, etc.) regarding the status of their educational achievement for the purpose of *MANA del Norte's* tracking/monitoring efforts. This information may be required from our funding sources and also provides an opportunity to support *MANA del Norte* scholarship recipients.

Instructions for Letters of Recommendation

Please provide a copy of these instructions to your recommenders

Scholarship applicants must provide two letters of recommendation from individuals (excluding relatives or Scholarship Committee members) who know you well and can judge your professional and/or academic ability and motivation for success. It is strongly recommended that at least one letter be from a faculty member/teacher who can speak to your academic ability. We encourage you to seek other letters from personal, professional and educational acquaintances (i.e., community and church leaders, teachers, school officials, employers, and/or volunteer site supervisors).

The following points must be addressed in the letters of recommendation:

1. Name, profession/title, address and telephone number of person making recommendation.
2. Capacity in which you have observed the applicant and the length of time you have known her.
3. Your evaluation of the applicant's past academic, employment, or volunteer record.
4. Your judgment of the applicant's ability to undertake and complete her education.
5. Your evaluation of the applicant's career potential.
6. Any other info about applicant you believe would assist the Scholarship Committee in their decision.

Recommendation letters can be submitted by **1)** being provided directly to the applicant in a sealed envelope, with the signature of the person making the recommendation written across the back flap of the envelope **OR 2)** the recommender may email recommendation letters to scholarship committee Co-Chair, Virginia Martinez-Fiske, directly at retgma@icloud.com

Sealed letters of recommendation must be submitted with the application packet on or before **June 30, 2023**. It is recommended that your letter be provided to the applicant no later than **one week prior to the posted deadline**, so submittal of her completed application packet is not delayed.

All information submitted will be kept confidential and will be known only to members of MANA del Norte's Scholarship Committee.
